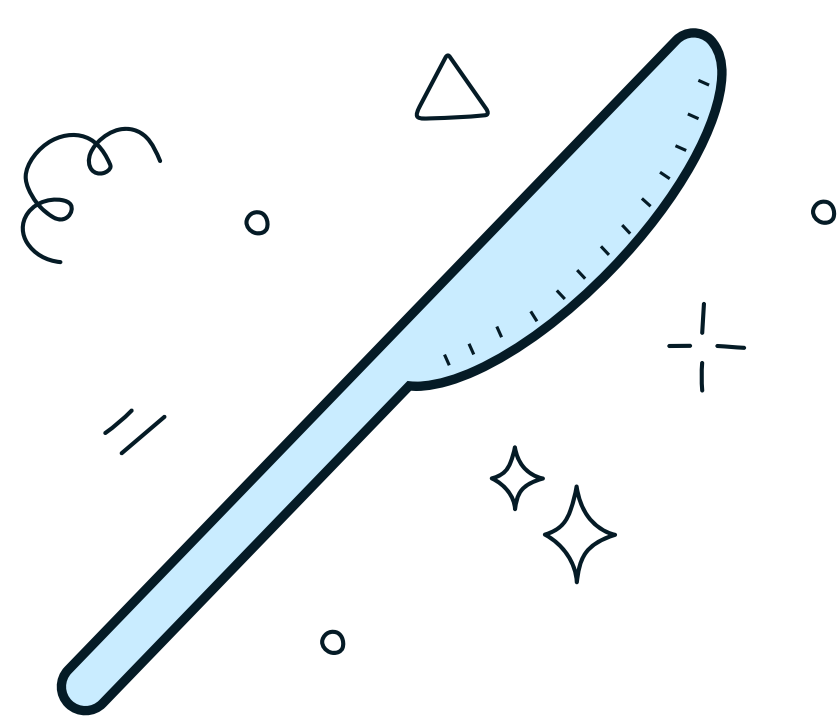


5 Overlooked Cleaning Tools You Need To Get



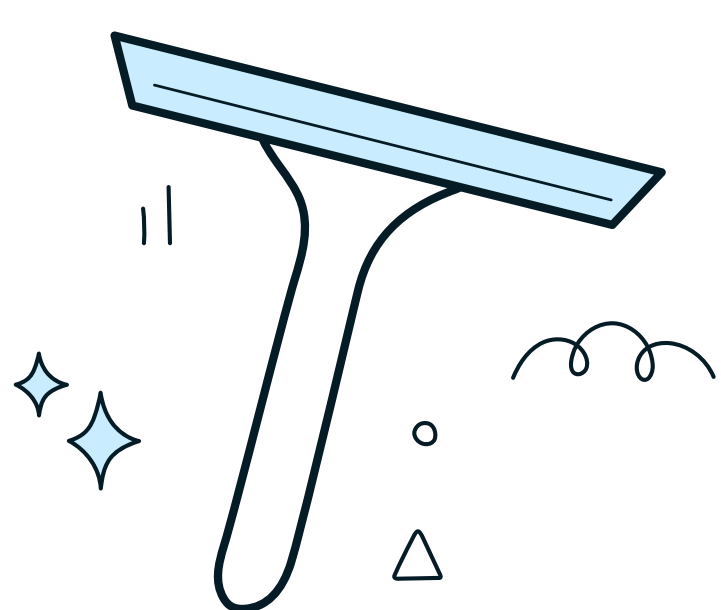
Butter Knife
